The 8th Annual Inter-Tribal Environmental Youth Camp is approaching: it will take place from June 25 – 28, 2018 at the Noyo-Bida Ranch in Fort Bragg on property owned by the Potter Valley Tribe. This annual event is organized by the Mendocino-Lake-Sonoma Tribal Environmental Programs (MLSTEP) and other departments of local tribes committed to providing our youth with valuable knowledge of the Natural Environment from a Native American perspective.

We are a 3-day camp for families and youth (targeting ages 8 to 17); attendance is 100 - 150 people. They will learn the benefits and wonders of the environment, thus motivating them to explore their natural world and promote interests in environmental science, biology, natural resource management and local cultural activities.

The following are considerations for participation in the event:

- **Pre-registration is very important;** registration packets are available from several sources:

- **Deadline for pre-registration is June 15, 2018**
- Each tribe should bring 2 – 5 gallon jugs of drinking water and a first aid kit
- Permission needed from PVT to bring camp trailers
- Tribes and families should bring their own tents, sleeping bags & other camping equipment. First aid kits are recommended; we will have some to use here. Meals, utensils and plates are provided for all participants.
- We try for a low-waste event; please try not to bring plastic or other disposable containers
